Reporting to the Contract Manager, the Civils Supervisor will be responsible for overseeing all civils/fibre construction activities. You will ensure that Grain Connects supply chain partners are carrying out site operations on time, to specific specification within Quality, Health and Safety and Environmental guidelines and within permit timeframes and conditions.

- ▶ Ensure contractors have site-specific method statements and risk assessments in place daily.
- ▶ Ensure all permits are submitted in good time and closed in good time.
- ▶ Liaise with the public, dealing with any issues that our network construction activities may have caused.
- ▶ Deputise for the Contracts Manager at Local Authority Highways/Roads and Contractor meetings.
